- Only entrants in the Circuit Class and Pleasure Class qualify to win the Outlaw Class prize

Rules & Regulations

- Captain's attendance at Captain's meeting is mandatory.
- Only Captain and crew are allowed on boats during the run.
- A minimum crew size of 2 people, maximum of 4.
- Everyone on board must wear a life jacket or P.F.D at all times.
- Crash Helmets Suggested. Enclosed cockpits must show secured knife and oxygen upon inspection. (See Captain's schedule)
- Passing of Pace Boat during prescribed times is not allowed. Violators will be disqualified from Best Time prize.
- No alcohol is to be consumed in or around the boats by anyone participating in the Million Dollar Run until their boat is finally tied up
- Visible display of identification numbers or boat name on both sides of each boat is required.
- No disqualification for Poker Prize (card Drawing)
- If course not completed or run incorrectly, the captain will only disqualified from "Fastest Time"
- Each vessel must have full safety equipment.
- Use of V.H.F., cell phone or other communication device is required to indicate a boat has dropped out of the race for whatever reason.
- Ignition safety tethers should be worn at all times.
- Safely landyards (kill switches) must be used during race.
- All boats must go to all card stops and collect their own cards.
- Maintain a safety zone of 200 feet clear on all sides of your boat when running.
- When running, pick a lane and stick to it. If it becomes necessary to change lanes, always check first for approaching traffic.
- Boats must stay 500yards from shore and 50 yards from buoys at all times.
- Pace boats and chase boats – yellow flags
- Main channel inside/outside green, channel posts marked with large yellow flags.
- All boats must follow rules of International Waters, please see attached.
- All boats must be docked at Royal Palms with all cards drawn by 4:00pm

There will be a half (.5) pace lap for each class. The rolling start will commence from the sound west side of the track. Once the pace boat has started the roll, captains and crews must keep their eyes on the pace boat for the wave of the green flag signifying the race has begun. Boats will travel around the course approximately four (4) miles where they will start the race with the waving of the green flag. Captains may have a problem seeing the green flag from the pace boat because of other boat spray.

Captains can look at the start/finish boat for the green flag which will wave also at the same time. **Note: A pace lap is not counted as a race lap.**

Even though the start begins approximately two and a half (2.5) miles at the start line, the race will officially start and the clock will start and finish at the start/finish line opposite Royal Palms. The race track will be used for all races (Circuit & Pleasure, Offshore) and has a total circumference of approximately 5.25 miles. Circuit & Pleasure boats will run five (5) laps for an overall 26.25 miles. Offshore class boats will run ten (10) laps for an overall 52.5 miles for their race.

Lack of compliance will result in disqualification from the event. As part of the safety criteria, it is agreed that standard flag colors will be used for the run and they are listed below. Please also see description of flags and hand signals attached.
